


Directions

We are 1/2 mile off the A52 in the village of Kingsley. Coming up the hill into Kingsley from Leek, **past the old brick works** on the left, turn sharp left at the bend at the top of the hill into Hazles Cross/Hollins Lane and the farm is 1/2 mile up the lane on the right. (Hollins Lane is U shaped and meets the A52 at either end.)

The flowers are at their best usually during February and March but this varies with the weather. The collection is housed mainly under cover so can be visited comfortably during inclement weather (in sensible shoes!) and includes posters on Hellebore biology and ecology.

The collection is owned by a world leading authority on Hellebores and Hellebore breeding. Plants are available for sale.
